- To collaborate closely with faculty members to understand their teaching needs and help integrate library resources into the curriculum and course planning.



Physical Facilities of Library:

Study Room: The library provides separate setting arrangement for boys, girls and faculty members. Therefore, students get the benefit of reading facilities. The total seating capacity of study hall for students is 40 and faculty is 10. The study room timing: 7.30 am to 5.15 pm.

Suggestion Box:

Library invites student's suggestions, questions, comments and concerns. The suggestion box is for the Libraries' patrons to communicate with the Libraries' administration. One separate Suggestion Box is kept inside the library for welcoming new suggestions.

Fire Safety:

A fire prevention system has been installed in the library to protect the books and other study material available in the library from fire. The librarians have been trained in the use of this fire prevention system. The library updates fire extinguisher every year.

First-Aid Box:

A first-aid kit or medical kit is a collection of supplies & equipment used in library to give immediate medical treatment. The no. of first-aid boxes is also increased. Right now, the library has 2 first aid boxes









ICT Facilities:

Shripatrao Chougule Arts and Science College Library of the institution is committed to provide latest E-resources to student academic & administrative staff. E-Resources enable the librarian to provide better service to the user community. The few considerable points are mentioned below:

ILMS:

The library is fully automated through Vidyasagar's Integrated Library Management System (ILMS) developed by Easy and Useful IT Solutions, Kolhapur, Maharashtra. The software provides full support in diverse areas such as library record maintenance, books management, barcode facility, books accession, membership, circulation, OPAC &Administration. The facilities like database backup facility, book reservation facility and the status of books can be easily accessed through this software. The catalogue of Shripatrao Chougule Arts and Science College Library can be accessed online as it supports OPAC.



NDL and N-LIST

Library subscribes N-list electronic resources package offered to the colleges by INFLIBNET. It consists of e-Journals and Ebooks which can be accessed by the user community of the college. Through N- List platform, users can get access more than 1,99,500+ e-books and 6,000+ e-journals and 6,00,000 e-books through NDL. CDs, DVDs:

The library purchased 66 CDs, DVDs & CD-ROMs on various topics to provide digital information among the students. It also has collection of CD-ROMs arrived with purchased books and journals. Library is committed to provide wider digital access to the learners.

Web OPAC:

The catalogue of Shripatrao Chougule Arts and Science College Library can be accessed online as it supports OPAC. The operations of the library are fully computerized and the Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) is accessible in library premises on 24x7 basis. It assists in searching the catalogue or locating books is available from the Help Desk.

Barcode:

The library has implemented an Online Barcode Facility to manage book circulation. All books are cataloged with unique barcodes, and transactions are recorded through the Vidyasagar Library Management System. Currently, only books are tracked using barcodes, and attendance is recorded based on issued books. The system does not yet use barcodes for tracking individual students or faculty.

Printer:

The library is well maintained and decorated. 03 computers are connected to a printer. Library has 01 inkjet printer.

CCTV Camera:

CCTV facility is made available in the library. CCTV cameras in the premises of library to identify visitors and employees, monitor work areas and ensure the security of the library premises.









Student-Centric Facilities:

1. Open Access:

Library provides an open access system to the students, academic and administrative staff. It provides numerous benefits: such as easy access of text books, reference books, journals, e-books, periodicals & question banks etc, to students & faculty members. The students & staff get the benefit of book bank facility, internet facility, reading room facility along with erecourse such as N-List, ShodhCanga, INFLIBNET etc.



2. Book Bank Service:

Book Bank Service is provided to the students in the 3" cycle of assessment. This book bank scheme is run for the Economically Backward/ Other Backward Class Students. Books regarding syllabus are issued to students for the semester and taken back after final examination is over. The funds for this scheme are raised from the Student Aid Fund of the college. From the Academic Year 2015-16 To 2017-18 library acquired sets of books from 'Shidhivinayak Trust' for the book bank scheme.

3. Books Issue Return Service:

The Library Committee formed its policy and mechanism. A library card is issued to every student when the student joins the College. This card is to be maintained for issuing textbooks, reference books and journals, etc. A student can borrow only two books at a time for a period of seven days. Stream wise days are allowed to the students for book issues and return service.

4. Internet Facilities:

Shripatrao Chougule Arts and Science College Library is a spacious & well equipped with latest technology. Internet facility available for students & faculties in working hours of library. There is a separate Internet Section in the library. 07 computers are made available for students with internet facility.

5. Reference Services:

Library has good collection of reference materials such as encyclopedias, dictionaries, competitive exam books etc.. Library provides reference services to both faculty and students

6. Question paper Set:

Library has also made provision for students to refer old question papers for preparing their University Level examinations. Students are allowed to take the photocopy of the question paper using their mobile phones.

7. QR Code:

The Library provides latest E-resources to the academic staff. Following services are available through QR Code- namely, N-list, NDL, Library OPAC, Marathi E-Books.

8. Service to community:

Shripatrao Chougule Arts and Science College Library always welcomes readers. It provides library services to the alumni and senior citizens of society as per their interest. It also maintains the record of the visitors.



Innovative Programmes: 2019-20 To 2023-24

Shripatrao Chougule Arts and Science College Library ' of the institution has initiated many innovative practices to ensure the growth of the library during the assessment period from 2019-20 to 2023-24. These practices have made the library environment more vibrant & energetic. Major innovative practices are:

1. Orientation Program:

The Library organizes an Orientation Program for the benefit the students. These programmes help the students, especially students of first year to understand the offered facilities and services of Shripatrao Chougule Arts and Science College Library. Expert's guidance is provided to them. They are encouraged to get familiar with library policy, structure, mechanism and place of library in academic growth. More than five (5) Programmes organized during the assessment period.

2. Reading Inspiration Day:

Every year, Shripatrao Chougule Arts and Science College Library of the institute celebrates 15th October as "Reading Inspiration Day" on the birth anniversary of Dr. A. P. J. Abdul Kalam. It helps everyone to grow mentally, emotionally & psychologically. It also open the doors of new knowledge to enlighten the minds. Students received the drive zestfully. Library also felicitates the students on this occasion.



3. Book Review:

Occasion of **Reading Inspirational Day**. The theme of the event was **''Mala Bhavalele Pustak'' (My Memorable Book)**, where teachers reviewed books that had left a significant impact on them. A total of 30 students participated, and they were later felicitated with books as a token of appreciation.

4. Book Exhibition:

Shripatrao Chougule Arts and Science College Library is considered to be the soul of the institute. During the assessment period, it started organizing praiseworthy student-centric programs entitled The Book Exhibition every year. It is a very noteworthy event hosted by the library to celebrate commemorative days. It helps to develop the reading habits among the stakeholders. Learners get familiar with the national leader and their biography.



5. Granth-Dindi:

The **Granth-Dindi** (**Procession**) was organized for the second time to celebrate **Marathi Rajyabhasha Din**. The event, aimed at promoting the Marathi language, was jointly organized by the **Department of Library** and the **Department of Marathi**.



Inside the Library:

1. Display of Faculty Publication:

The Faculty Publications Display (7) is located in the Library. The display features a complete collection of books written by faculty members. The library purchases 5 copies of faculty books for the collection, so the non-circulating copy is for the publication display and the circulating copy is available in the stacks for checkout.

2. New Arrivals:

Shripatrao Chougule Arts and Science College Library introduced a separate section named as New Arrival for the students and staff. New books are kept on the "New Arrivals" section for a limited amount of time in order that library users may have a chance to browse new acquisitions. New arrival service informs students and faculty about books processed and periodicals received on different dates.

3. Visitors Books:

Dignitaries of various fields visit Shripatrao Chougule Arts and Science College Library and Institute. The Guest Book is a way for visitors to leave a note after they visit a Shripatrao Chougule Arts and Science College Library. The library has maintained the opinions/remarks/ feedback of scholars/ stakeholders of various fields are also recorded and kept carefully in the library.

4. Rare Book Collection:

Special collection contains around 147 rare books concerning a range of diverse subjects.

5. Donated Books:

On special occasions such as faculty birthdays, both **teaching and non-teaching staff, also ex-principals** donate books to the library as a gesture of goodwill. **management members** also contributed by donating books. 42 dignitaries, present professors, Alumini and some writers gifted their collection of books to the library. The number of total gifted books is 973 which is commendable figure.
